Our tour will commence at 08.30hrs and proceed to Thapong Visual Arts (a small gallery of modern and contemporary local work). We will stop for coffee/tea at their restaurant on their premises before commencing on the tour.

Thapong Visual Arts is located in the village where we find again the old prison and other old residential buildings.



We then proceed to the Three Dikgosi Monument where we will view the sculptures of the three tribal chiefs who played a significant role in bringing independence to our country.

From there we will visit Gabane Pottery in the Village of Gabane where the potters use the potter's wheel to manufacture pottery. You will be taught the basics in pottery!

We proceed south to Manyana rock paintings which are situated in the base of Kolobeng hills, we will view paintings of giraffe, gemsbok and human figures which resembles cultural significance also there is Mmasechele cave which was used by the chiefs wife for protection from the Dimawe battle. We will visit the Livingstone's tree which is also located in Manyana village where according to tradition the tree was used for preaching under by David Livingstone. Our packed lunch will be had here. We proceed to Kumakwane village where we find the remains of Livingstone's house and the church, also several graves including of his daughters.

This is the last historical site of our trip; we will be guided by the National Museum Staff. We will then have an option to go to Mokolodi nature reserve for a sundowner or to your preferred hotel for a drink and before calling it a day.
